"The Chancellor's Medal is the highest honor bestowed on individuals for exemplary and extraordinary service to the campus," the statement said.

The lecture series is sponsored by the offices of the chancellor and the provost.

Fissore was also an embryologist in the in-vitro fertilization program at Brigham and Women's Hospital's department of obstetrics, gynecology and reproductive biology and Harvard Medical School from 1990-93. From 1983 to 1984 he was a veterinary assistant in the veterinary practice of Dr. Roberto Magnasco in Canals, Cordoba, Argentina.

Fissore earned a degree as a veterinary surgeon from the University of Buenos Aires in 1983; was a resident at the School of Veterinary Medicine at the University of California, Davis from 1984 to 1988; earned a master of preventive veterinary medicine from the University of California Davis in 1988; earned a diplomate ACT from the American College of Theriogenology in 1988, and earned a doctorate in veterinary and animal sciences from UMass Amherst in 1993.

Professor Fissore also served as a postdoctoral fellow in reproductive biology at Harvard Medical School and Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston from 1988 to 1989.
