## Weary drivers think the worse is yet to come gas pricewise

Gas prices in Massachusetts have not changed in two weeks, but many local motorists believe that trend will not last.

"It's not going to stop. It's not going to be less. It's going to keep going up," said one Attleboro resident while fueling up Monday at the Gas Plus on Pleasant Street. "I don't even look at the gas prices. I can't change them," she said.

A statewide survey Monday by AAA of Southern New England found an average price of \$4.06 per gallon for regular-grade self-serve, 2 cents below the national average.


Prior to the past two weeks of steadying prices, the average had increased for 10 consecutive weeks, to rise above \$4-a-gallon for the first time.

"I think as long as people keep paying the increased price it will keep going up," said Robert McAllister of Attleboro. "It's supply and demand." McAllister said he would support any alternatives to bring

demand down.

"I think it is crazy. It's insane that they are getting away with this," said his wife, Donna, referring to the high prices oil companies are charging.

However, some motorists were more optimistic.



"I think it's a good sign. I think they might go down a little bit. I'm hoping," said Diane Ward who commutes from Bourne to work in Attleboro. Looking ahead, drivers speculated on what gas prices will be like by the end of summer. One driver said she expects gas to be around \$5 a gallon by the end of summer. Delores Santaniello of Attleboro agreed. She said she expects prices to jump right after the July Fourth holiday... "Americans have let this happen.
